GOVERNOR INSPECTS TREE CENSUS AT RAJ BHAVAN

Thiru CH.Vidyasagar Rao, Governor of Tamil Nadu inspected the Tree Census carried out by the Botanists, Researchers, Scientists and students of the Tamil Nadu Agricultural University at Raj Bhavan, Chennai today (11.11.2016).

The Governor enquired the students about cataloguing of trees and the progress made. He also asked the researchers about the rare and valuable species of trees identified by them.
