Hon'ble Governor said, "I am delighted to be here on the occasion of Platinum Jubilee Celebrations of Alagappa College of Technology, which is one of the campuses of Anna University. It is always a matter of joy to be among radiant young faces of students and alumini of AC Tech who are full of hope and cheer. It is a matter of pride that the youth of India represent the true wealth of India.

I was told that the institute was started by University of Madras with contribution from Philanthropist Vallal Dr. Alagappa Chettiar expressing interest in starting unique programmes in the fields of chemical, textile and leather. Alagappa College of Technology was started in the year 1944 with the intake of just 43 students. I am happy that today the college has 9 undergraduate programmes and 13 post graduate programmes with the intake of 800 students every year.

- Leather technology in partnership with Central Leather Research Institute, which is a CSIR Institute.
- Undergraduate Professional Biotechnology to be the first in the country
