Today, the NSS has about 40 lakh volunteers enrolled in 391 Universities, sixteen thousand two hundred and seventy eight (16,278) Colleges and twelve thousand four hundred and eighty three (12,483) Senior Secondary Schools. Tamil Nadu alone has a strength of Four lakh thirty eight thousand eight hundred (4,38,800) students in 52 Universities with a coverage of one thousand three hundred and thirty four (1,334) colleges and one thousand nine hundred and fifty three (1,953) Higher Secondary Schools.

India has a population of more than 130 crore and the 40 lakh volunteers of the NSS is still a small number in comparison. It is a matter of satisfaction that Tamil Nadu, which accounts for less than 7% of the population of India, has nearly 12% representation in the NSS. I request all the NSS Volunteers to come forward to do service for the development of villages as dreamed by Mahatma Gandhi.

The sole **aim** of the NSS is to provide hands-on experience to young students in **delivering community service**. The **Motto of NSS "NOT ME BUT YOU"** reflects the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for self-less service. Never forget it. Always keep it in mind and follow it. For, it is adopting the message in actual life that we will sow seeds of collective happiness.

The young members of the contingent of the NSS who participated in the Republic Day Parade at Delhi have brought glory to our State. Your selection for the
