It gives me pleasure to be present amongst all of you on this occasion and declare open the 61st All India Police Duty Meet. The Police Department has an important role in the establishment of such a model of government. They need to be get motivated and led with a passion, aimed at making it the best in the country.

Tamil Nadu has a number of bold and pioneering initiatives to be proud about in the field of police administration. The concept of All Women Police Stations was started in Tamil Nadu. New initiatives are being introduced to provide assistance to States for upgradation of police infrastructure, forensic science laboratories, institutions and the equipment to plug critical gaps in the criminal justice system. Police Stations will be integrated to set up a national data base of crime and criminals' records. It will be linked with other pillars of criminal justice system such as 'prisons, forensic science laboratories and prosecution offices.

The Government of Tamil Nadu has been supporting the police force with a lot of initiatives and welfare measures. Recruitment to augment the police force and construction of Buildings for police establishments are worth mentioning. Several welfare measures has been initiated by the Government of Tamil Nadu for the police personnel that have helped to keep the morale of the Tamil Nadu Police force high. I commend the Government of Tamilnadu for the sustained measures taken to keep the police force upgraded and motivated.

Tamil Nadu Police has carved a niche for itself in the maintenance of law and order, control of crime and handling of mass congregations. Tamil Nadu has to it's credit a brilliant record of service. This wouldn't have been possible without the tireless efforts of ever vigilant police personnel. My appreciation is due to every police man and police woman who works tirelessly to keep the state safe and secure.
