## MEETING OF HON'BLE GOVERNOR OF TAMIL NADU WITH THE PRINCIPALS OF KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS OF CHENNAI REGION AT RAJ BHAVAN, CHENNAI ON 17.06.2022

Hon'ble Governor of Tamil Nadu, Thiru. R.N. Ravi conducted the meeting of Principals of Kendriya Vidyalayas in Chennai Region, interacted with them at Raj Bhavan, Chennai, today, 17.06.2022, and reviewed the implementation of National Education Policy (NEP) - 2020.

Hon'ble Governor was impressed upon the academic and sports activities being conducted at schools under their region. The programmes of orientation courses, Out of the Box thinking, teachers' training, NIPUN Bharat, (National Institute for Proficiency Reading & Understanding Need) courses, NISHTHA courses (National Institute for School Heads & Teachers Holistic Advancement), Institute of Higher Level Education (IHL) and various activities that undertaken by the Kendriya Vidyalayas including language skills, LSRW programmes (Listen, Speak, Read and Write),

This will encourage the studying students to perform well in academics.

Hon'ble Governor said that India is rich in youth resources in the world. This is the right time to implement the NEP in schools that has been rolled out develop our Nation 'The Knowledge Capital' of the world. He emphasised that there is need to implement NEP in letter and spirit to reap

benefits for improving the capabilities and potential knowledge with skills of the students to enable them to compete and conquer.

Hon'ble Governor listened to the problems and the areas that need to be looked into, for example, the need of infrastructure facilities, digital platforms at school levels, student and teacher ratio, scarcity of trained teachers and so on in implementing NEP - 2020 at Kendriya Vidyalayas.
