The country since the time immemorial, has very strong traditional system of medicines which is much in practice even today. The traditional Indian medicine approach is differed from the European and Western medicine approach which is more analytic in nature.

Hon'ble Governor mentioned the ancient medical approach of Siddars and epic works of Thirumoolar performed several thousand years ago. His work on Thirumandiram, yoga, asanas and meditation are timeless wisdom for the people.

Hon'ble Governor brought out that the world is looking at India as a health sector partner. India has provided COVID vaccine to more than 150 countries for free. We are promoting alternative medicine system. Today, export of Indian Ayush products are worth 18 billion Dollars.

Hon'ble Governor added that Tamil Nadu is proud land of Rishi Pathanjali who authored and compiled a number of Yoga Sutras and classical yoga texts. Governor explained several thousand years ago, Yoga Siddhar, Thirumoolar wrote 3000 of verses yoga Thirumandhiram in which he described various aspects of Yoga in detail including narration of the eight limbs of yoga viz., yama (abstinences), niyama (observances), asana (yoga postures), pranayama (breath control), pratyahara (withdrawal of the senses), dharana (concentration), dhyana (meditation) and samadhi (absorption).

Hon'ble Governor added that one great Tamil Siddhar Gorakhnath spread yoga in various parts of Bharat .
