With distinguished initiatives and inspirational efforts, Lal Bahadur Shastri paved a strong platform for great India to become self reliant in food and security. His famous slogan for India, Jai Jawan, Jai Kisan and Jai Hind is still inspiring and motivating the people to work for Nation building.

Hon'ble Governor applauded the great contributions of our freedom fighters, National leaders and Scientists by which India which was suffering from huge food scarcity after independence has now been made up as food surplus country and also the country is feeding other starving Nations.

Hon'ble Governor highlighted the contributions of unsung heroes and freedom fighters in Tamil Nadu for Nation's freedom. He stressed that it is the responsibility of Nation and the people to be grateful to these Heroes for their great services and sacrifices.

Hon'ble Governor while recalling the services of freedom fighter V.O.Chidambaranar, highlighted that the Toothukudi Port in Tamil Nadu which is one of the major ports in the country was brought to reality by Lal Bahadur Shastri.

Hon'ble Governor reiterated that with remarkable contributions of Shastri Ji, today our Nation is marching ahead with renewed confidence in the crucial period of Amrit Kal in becoming self reliant Nation and to reach destiny of becoming world leader by the year 2047 when India will be celebrating 100<sup>th</sup> year of independence.
